With reference to the Steamers "KABALO", "KABINDA",  
"KAMBOVE" & "KATANGA", belonging to the Cie. Africaine de Naviga-  
tion, we are forwarding, under separate cover, a plan, in duplicate,  
together with a specification, in duplicate, respecting a chamber  
which it is proposed to fit in the No. 2 tween decks of these  
vessels for carrying explosive or benzine in drums.

The chamber has to conform to the Suez Canal requirements,  
it has to be watertight & capable of being flooded at any time  
if necessary. The Owners require it to be tested filled with  
water to the upper deck & to be built & tested under our  
Supervision & to be accordance with the Society's requirements.

The plan has been discussed with the Owners' Superintendent  
as well as with the contractors, the Mercantile Marine Engineering  
Works, and it is submitted for the approval of the Committee.
