Précis of particulars of Casualty This vessel is reported to have been attacked by aircraft in the North Sea on the 30th January 1940. She caught fire and stranded and later slipped off and sank.

SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

"VOREDA"
It was officially stated yesterday that the British tanker "Voreda" has now sunk. The circumstances in which this vessel was lost have not previously been announced, and last week it was stated that her sinking could not be verified. She was the tanker which was attacked by enemy aircraft on Jan. 30, and after catching fire she went ashore. Her crew were saved. Presumably, the vessel has since slipped off and sunk. The "Voreda", a vessel of 7216 tons gross, built in 1935, was owned by Gow, Harrison & Co.
