I have to acquaint you I am in receipt of a letter from the Society's Surveyors at Copenhagen in which they state that the steamer "CHRISTIANSBORG" is expected to arrive at Vlaardingen on the 22nd or 23rd instant, when it is the Owners' desire to have the Convention ordinary and timber deck cargo freeboards marked.
