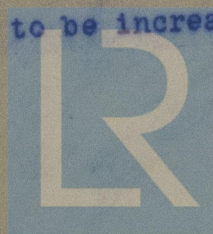

Dear Sir,

With further reference to our letter of the 3rd February last respecting the Convention Freeboards for the motor vessel "CHRISTIANSBORG", we beg to inform you that we have now received a letter from the Danish Authorities, which translated reads as follows:-

"In connection with the Ministry's letter of the 29th January last respecting the Freeboards for the cargo vessel "CHRISTIANSBORG" - Control No. C. 299 - we herewith inform you that the Ministry under the circumstances dispense with the following requirements of the above letter, viz:-  
the coamings for four ventilators on the forecastle deck to be increased to 915 m/m in height,  
the airpipes on the poop deck to be increased to 457 m/m in height,
