On account of damage during heavy weather, repairs or renewals effected to shell and keel plates, shell riveting, margin brackets etc., and minor repairs carried out.

On account of wear and tear repairs or renewals effected to bulkheads, framing, hatches etc., and minor repairs effected.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with fresh record of survey 1,40 and notation of S.S.No.3 - 1,40.
