Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 5th instant respecting the motor ship "BRITISH TRIUMPH", and to express the deep sympathy of the Committee of this Society in the loss you have sustained through the sinking of this vessel by mine in the North Sea on the 13th ultimo.

As permission has been received from the Government to record in the Society's Register Book, with Owners' consent, such Shipping War Losses as are reported in the Public Press, I have to acquaint you that it is proposed to make a record of "Sunk - War Loss 2.40" against this vessel's name in the Register Book, but before taking any action I shall be glad to learn whether you have any objection to this course being adopted in this instance.
