"A REDORD OF * L.M.C. HAS BEEN RECOMMENDED SUBJECT TO
"AUTOMATIC VALVES BEING FITTED TO ALL SETTLING TANK DRAIN"
"PIPES".

For your information we might add that this vessel has been built under special survey at Bilbao Spain, and sailed from that port a few days ago in an uncompleted condition.

Unfortunately owing to non-delivery of a letter from the Bilbao Surveyors regarding this case, we were in ignorance of details and ourselves acted without prejudice in completing several parts of the survey until receiving confirmation of the vessel's class by cable from the Surveyors to-day.

The parts seen and examined at this port are as follows:-

R.M.C. Insulation, thermometer tubes, brine pipes & machinery under working conditions.

Nothing has been done at this time towards the completion of LMC. survey.

Under the circumstances you are, of course, at liberty to issue a provisional certificate for the machinery
