We are forwarding herewith Verification Form Rpt C.12 (a) for the Convention Freeboard assigned to the above vessel.

The conditions of assignment as set forth in your letter F. dated 11th October 1932, have been complied with as under:-

- 1) Air Pipes from the Oil Tanks provided with gauzes, those from water tanks provided with efficient canvas covers.
- 2) Suitable provision made for rigging life lines, available for use in any part of the ship which may have to be used by the crew in the regular working of the ship.
- 3) One tarpaulin and battening down arrangements fitted to the small hatchway in the open passage of the forecastle and chain locker openings in the same position provided with steel watertight covers.
