## SHIPS FEARED LOST

British "Castlemoor" and  
Dutch "Saba"

It was announced yesterday that the British steamer *Castlemoor*, of 6574 tons gross, is so much overdue that she must be presumed to be lost. Hope, however, has not yet been given up for the crew of 42. The *Castlemoor*, built by W. Doxford & Sons, Ltd., Sunderland, in 1922, was owned by Runciman Shipping Company, Ltd., of Newcastle and London.

The British steamer *Castlemoor* (6574 tons) is so much overdue that she is presumed lost. The owners, the Moor Line, Limited, of Newcastle, stated yesterday that hope for the crew of 42 had not been given up.
