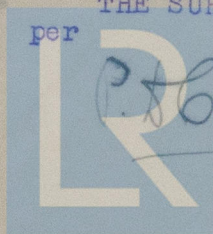

With reference to the Freeboard Verification forwarded herewith, we have to inform you that the following requirements have been carried out :-

- (1) The broken 2" diameter air pipe has been renewed 36" in height.
- (2) Manilla lifelines have been fitted on port and starboard sides of the Freeboard Deck all fore and aft.
- (3) All broken glasses in the side lights and engine room skylights have been renewed.
- (4) The damaged wood door to port side Engineers' alleyway has been repaired.
