FREEBOARD REPORT on the

S. S. CASTLEMOOR


It is submitted the freeboards given on the accompanying form being those required by the Tables merit approval, the same to be marked on the vessel's sides, inserted in the certificate of classification, and recorded in the Register Book, subject to

- 1 The 2' diameter air pipe, at present broken off at the deck, being renewed 36" in height.
- 2 Suitable provision being made for rigging lifelines which should be available for use in any part of the ship which might have to be used by the crew in the regular working of the ship.
- 3 The glasses in the sidelights & engine room skylight being renewed where broken.
- 4 The damaged wood door on the port side of the engineers alleyway being repaired to the surveyors satisfaction.

The freeboards computed under the Convention being in excess of those at present assigned the latter have been reassigned.
