## Swedish Tanker Torpedoed

It was reported yesterday that the Swedish motor tanker *Sveaborg* had been torpedoed off the Scottish coast while on a voyage from the Dutch West Indies to Sweden. It was understood that the entire crew were saved. The *Sveaborg*, of 9076 tons gross, is owned by Stockholm Rederi A/B Svea, of Stockholm, and was built in Germany in 1931.

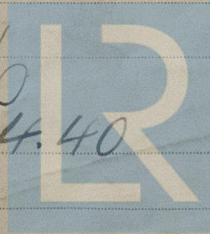
