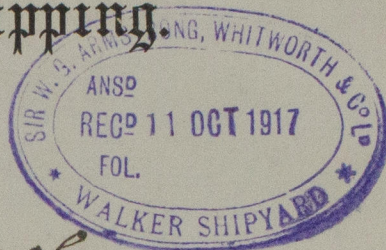

CERTIFICATE FOR CAST STEEL Anchor Head

This is to Certify that R. W. Dodridge

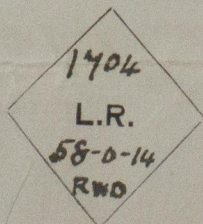
the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of  
Messrs. Blackett, Hutton & Co. Ltd. Guisborough, Yorks  
examine and test at their works on the 13th March 1917  
a cast steel Anchor Head, weighing 58.125 cwt.,  
and, as far as could be ascertained, found it to be a good casting.

After the Head had been dropped from a clear height of  
Twelve feet on to an iron slab, it was hammered whilst  
suspended, and gave no indication of defects.

A satisfactory bending test was made from a test piece cast  
with the Head.

This Head is intended for Joseph Wright & Co. Ltd. Tipton  
and is marked:—  
Staffs.

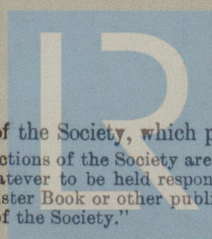
