The Surveyor states that the shafts, crossheads and air coolers for the compressors were examined at this time. The condenser supplied is an added unit taken from the Owners' storeroom at Bayonne, was not new but was tested to the satisfaction of the Surveyor. The vessel was scheduled for drydocking next month when the outstanding items mentioned in your letter would have been dealt with, but she is now reported to have fallen a victim to enemy action.
