I have to report that I found N^o 2 Shroud on the Starboard Fore Derrick Post; N^o 2 Shroud on the Port Main Derrick Post; Wasted and Fitted. Recommend these to be renewed. Main Mast: Wasted and Fitted in the body of the Mast. Recommend the Mast to be lifted out, scaled and cleaned for a further examination. Topmast: Fleet to be examined when lifted out. Lower Shackles of all Rigging Crews to be Fitted, Fitted, and repaired where necessary. Derrick Posts, Spars, other Rigging and Ironwork in good condition.
