

With reference to your letter of the 18th August last respecting the Convention ordinary cargo freeboards computed in case of the steamer "FRYKEN" on the basis of the information supplied in Stockholm report C.11 No.3635, which is returned herewith together with the computation, I beg to enclose the notification form of the new freeboards which have now been marked on the vessel's sides. *(copy of prov. cert.)*

In order to put this vessel into such a condition as will satisfy the Swedish Authorities that their requirements for sailing ships have been complied with, the following have been tried out, viz:

- Air pipes provided with means of closing.

- Life lines fitted on after deck.


The Swedish freeboard certificates issued in this case have been dated the 10th October, 1932, and 1937, respectively.
