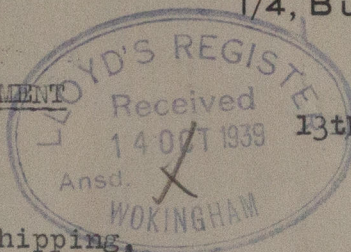

Dear Sir,

s.s. " ELENA R."

With reference to your letter of the 11th inst.,  
respecting the above vessel, we beg to inform you as  
follows:

When the ship discharged her cargo at Ymuiden  
in August last, we telegraphed the master to wait there  
for sailing orders and " ...meantime repair rivets...."

Four days after, i.e. the 27th August, the ship  
sailed to South Atlantic, but we received no intimation  
of the repairs having been actually effected. The circumstances  
in which the vessel sailed were such that communication with her  
was not considered advisable.

The matter may be cleared on return of the vessel  
to this side from Rosario, from which port she is about  
to sail in the next day or so.

The requirements contained in the second paragraph  
of your letter are borne in mind, and we will see that they  
are attended to in due course.
