Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 18th of last month respecting the Freeboard assignment of the ss. "ELENA R", I beg to enclose the freeboard verification form Rpt.C. 12(a) in connection with the above mentioned matter.

Suitable provision has been made for rigging lifelines, which shall be available for use in all parts of the Vessel which might have to be used by the crew in the regular working thereof.

A hatchway 1'-0" X 1'-0" with a bulbangle coaming 9 X 3½ X .44 and steel hinged W.T. cover, thick .40 and provided with 8 screw down bolts for securing has been substituted for the flush scuttle in the forecastle.

The ventilators over 36" in height are specially supported.

The Official Number and Signal Letters have not been inserted in the Rpt.C 12(a) as they were not yet available, but will be reported as soon as same are in our possession.
