This certificate concluded with the phrase "to enable the vessel to proceed to a U.K. or Continental port".

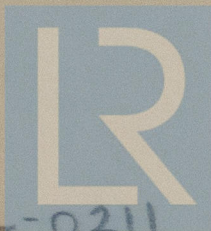
