Dear Sir,

F. I have to acquaint you that in May last the Society's Survey at Baltimore was instructed to carry out a general examination of the Steamer "ELENA R" for the purpose of ascertaining if the condition of the ship was satisfactory with a view to the issue of a provisional certificate to enable the vessel to proceed to a Continental port for the purpose of completing the Special Survey. The general examination, however, was carried out and the certificate issued before the Secretary's letter was received, and the certificate was made valid to cover a voyage to a United Kingdom port.

The vessel is now at Liverpool and the Owners desire that a further provisional certificate be issued to enable the vessel to proceed to Amsterdam in ballast, where the survey will be carried out.

I shall therefore be glad if you will be good enough to arrange for a provisional freeboard certificate on Rpt.10 to be issued.

A memorandum of the freeboards to be incorporated in the certificate is enclosed.
