

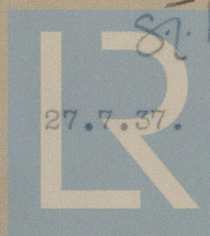

On the 25th May, the Baltimore Surveyor was instructed to carry out a General Examination for the purpose of ascertaining if the condition of the vessel was satisfactory with a view to the issue of a Provisional Freeboard Certificate to enable the vessel to proceed to a Continental Port for the purpose of completing the Special Survey. The General Examination was carried out and the Certificate issued, however, before the Secretary's letter was received, and the Certificate was made valid to cover a voyage to a United Kingdom port.

The vessel has now arrived at Liverpool and the Owners desire that a further Provisional Certificate to enable the vessel to proceed to Amsterdam in ballast, where the survey will be carried out.

IT IS SUBMITTED the Liverpool Surveyors be advised, and instructed to issue a provisional freeboard Certificate on Rpt.10 to enable the vessel to proceed to Amsterdam in ballast. A memorandum of the freeboards to be incorporated in the Certificate should be forwarded to them.
