With reference to your representative's call at this office today respecting the steamer "HUNINDIES" I beg to acquaint you that the minimum requirements to permit of the vessel proceeding as a classed ship from the United States to a port in Holland for repairs and Special Survey No.1 are that she be examined in drydock, her general condition ascertained and any necessary repairs effected to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors, the Boiler Survey carried out, steam pipes, sea connections and screwshaft examined, circulating pump and forward attached pump repaired.

With regard to the vessel's freeboard, I would point out that Convention freeboards have not been assigned, and the Society's Surveyors are being informed that provided they satisfy themselves as to the condition of the ship, having regard to the draught desired, they may issue a provisional certificate, if one is desired.
