It would appear from the plans and particulars, in this Office that to complete ^(after an early n°3) the Special Survey No.1, due 3,35, the following remain:-

- all holds (except No.4 hold) to be examined;
- plating in way of sidelights to be examined;
- poop and forecastle spaces to be examined;
- bridge space (except bridge bunkers) to be examined;
- fore and after peak tanks to be examined and tested;
- double bottom tanks Nos. 1 & 2 port side and 5 & 6, port and starboard to be examined;
- double bottom tanks Nos. 1,2,4,5 & 6 to be tested;
- coal shoot and saddleback to be examined;
- engine and boiler space to be examined except tank top under boilers and boiler bearers;
- tunnel to be examined internally;
- decks, hatchways, hatch covers etc., anchors, cables, chain locker, masts, spars, rigging to be examined, mast wedges to be removed (if fitted) for examination;
- steering gear and its connections, ventilators, general equipment, pumps, watertight doors, windlass, air and sounding pipes to
