

We have your letter of the 30th April and note with surprise what remains to be done to complete this vessel's Second No: 1 Special Survey.

We still feel that the extent of the bottom damage repairs and the fitting of the Gotaverken Turbo Compressor has not been fully appreciated by your Committee, and we enclose herewith a copy of the account for Owners repairs and also copy of the turbo compressor installation specification.
