S.S. "JOYOUS"

We are in receipt of your letter of the 3rd April in which you notify us that this vessel is now due for her Special Survey, Second No: 1.

This is following an early No: 3 Survey, and we feel that in view of the extensive bottom damage which was repaired at Amsterdam in December 1934 and the boiler room tank was passed, the docking and all ballast tanks, machinery and boilers should be taken as having passed Survey.

On completion of the foregoing repairs the whole of the double-bottom tanks were filled and tested to the satisfaction of your Surveyor, also there was extensive renewals and repairs to the machinery, the whole of which was opened up and passed by your Surveyor before the fitting of a Gotaverken Turbo Compressor.


