Messrs. A.-B. Götaverken of this port have received an order for a turbine compressor for the steamer "JAMESON", No. 78502 in the Register Book, and as the matter was very urgent they have already sent to Rotterdam one of their turbines in stock.

The turbo compressor in question has been built under our special survey and all the requisite requirements, including the racing tests, have been complied with except that the casing has not been examined and tested by hydraulic pressure by us, but by a Surveyor to the Norske Veritas as per enclosed survey report.

At the request of the Builders it is submitted that this turbo compressor be approved in this instance.
