





With reference to the Freeboard Marking Verification Form forwarded herewith for the above vessel, the Captain states that the Special Survey No. 2 has recently been completed at Hull, and we have to state that the fittings and appliances for the protection of openings, the guard rails, the freeing ports and the means of access to the Crew's quarters have been maintained on the ship in as effective a condition as they were in when the Freeboard Certificate was issued, and no material alterations have taken place in the hull or superstructures of the ship which affect the positions of the load lines.
