Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that the Convention freeboard certificate in respect of the steamer "HARFRY" will expire at the end of the present month, i.e., at the expiration of the year of grace of the Special Survey No.2.

It is observed that the vessel arrived at Goole on the 8th instant and I shall be glad to learn whether she is now under inspection for the completion of the Special Survey.

In the event of this being so, you should forward, when the survey is nearing completion, a verification of marking form together with a statement that the conditions of assignment are still complied with in order that fresh certificates valid for five years may be issued.

I may add that no fee should be charged for the Renewal Survey in this instance.
