With reference to your letter F. of the 31st ultimo and the Convention Freeboard requirements, we beg to inform you that these have now been complied with as follows:-

- (1) 1 additional freeing port 2'-9" x 1'-10" each side, cut in the Raised Quarter Deck bulwarks. -
- (2) The ventilator in the fore well having height of 7'-6" fitted with efficient support. -
- (3) Steel cover of stokehold grating repaired. -
- (4) Satisfactory means of closing provided for all vents and air pipes. -
- (5) Snifting holes drilled in the top of the bend of air pipes on the Raised Quarter Deck. -
- (6) The locks of the doors in the forecastle bulkhead and machinery casing on the Raised Quarter Deck repaired or renewed as necessary. -

The Owners Superintendent states that the Special Survey No.2. will be advanced at first convenient opportunity.
