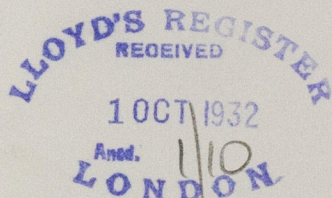

Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 29th instant having reference to the new freeboard of the steamer "SEA VENTURE", we beg to inform you of the following alterations now effected.

(a) Wood plugs and canvas covers fitted for closing the openings of all the air pipes.

(b) Lifeline (manilla rope) provided between bridge and poop decks for the protection of the crew.

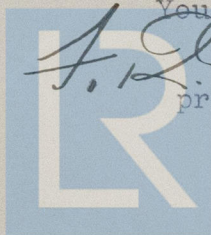
Regarding items 1, 4 and 5 of assignment letter dated 15th April, 1932., we beg to state that wood plugs and canvas covers are supplied for all ventilators, shifting boards in the after end bulkheads of the bridge and forecastle are fitted for the full height of the openings and the bolts securing the plates which close the openings in the bridge front pass through both the plate and the bulkhead.
