"SEA VENTURE" desire retain existing freeboard" and have now to enclose the assignment letter in respect of this ship.

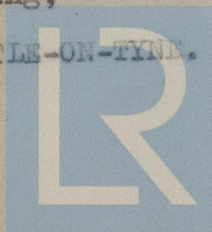
I have to add that full particulars of the case have been forwarded to the Society's Surveyors at Grimsby and on completion of the survey the Convention freeboard certificates will be issued.
