Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of yesterday and telegram of this morning relative to the Convention freeboard survey of the steamer "SEA VENTURE" and note that the new freeboards are to be marked on the ship's sides at Boston early next week and that the Owners do not desire the assignment of timber freeboards.

With reference to your request to be supplied with the Convention certificates, I have to enclose herewith a copy of a letter dated the 15th April last which was addressed to the Owners in regard to this case, and to refer you to the last paragraph enquiring whether it is desired to have the existing or Convention freeboards assigned to this ship.
