


"STONEGATE"

Arising out of this decision, attention is called to the case of the steamer "STONEGATE", 5044 tons, owned by Messrs. Turnbull, Scott & Co., which was reported sunk by the pocket battleship "DEUTSCHLAND" in the North Atlantic on the 5th ultimo.

In this case the Owners asked that it should be made clear that the vessel was sunk by enemy action, and in view of this request the case was referred to the General Committee by the Classing Committee on the 7th instant.

The notation "Sunk - War Loss 10,39" would meet the Owners' wishes, and it is accordingly submitted this record should now be made.
