be complied with so far as they are applicable.

It is noted that the feed water passes through a direct contact heater, and it should be pointed out that if the heating steam is taken from the main engine casing or from auxiliaries using superheated steam, suitable arrangements should be made to filter the feed water which comes in contact with this steam, or alternatively to eliminate any traces of oil in the steam before it enters the direct contact heater, by means of an efficient oil trap.
