The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

Action has been deferred for examination in dry dock after grounding and permanent repairs being effected in way of No. 2 tank (p.s.).

The Gothenburg Surveyors report the vessel afloat and with a view to the postponement of the 4th S.S. No. 2, which would become due at the end of this month, a general examination has now been carried out.

The Surveyor is of the opinion that the Special Survey may be postponed until some convenient time within the year of grace.

The vessel was last examined in dry dock in May last and in view of the examination then held, it is submitted the proposed postponement of the Special Survey might be agreed to.

It is further submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey.
