Dear Sir,

I have to inform you that Convention Ordinary and Timber Deck Cargo Freeboards have been computed in the case of the steamer "LIANA" on the basis of the information supplied on Malmo Report C/11No. 1090 and on the assumption that the openings in the bridge front are closed by Class 1 appliances. The penalty required by the Swedish Authorities for the omission of a poop has been applied in the case of the timber deck cargo freeboards. The report and computation are enclosed herewith, together with the freeboard certificate, in triplicate.
