We have forwarded today the report on freeboard m/s "SLIEDRECHT"; please see your letter dated 18th instant and the particulars as pencilled thereon have been filled in.

The guard rail supports on the gangway are fastened by through bolts, the second rail is being fitted.

The doors closing the openings in the poop and forecastle are being made capable of being manipulated from both sides of the bulkheads, but the Owners were of opinion that in the case of the fore-castle which door is always closed one side would be sufficient.

As regards the open rail you will notice that the whole deck is one well there are no end bulkheads at bridge deck and it is considered that this arrangement is in order.
