particulars of Casualty This vessel was sunk by aircraft at Barcelona on the 27th December, 1938.

She was subsequently refloated and as no repairs were carried out the Committee decided in all the circumstances to make a record of "Sunk 12,38 - Now refloated" and to expunge her class.

The steamer has since been seized by the Spanish Government, has been renamed "CASTILLO ALMANSA" and has resumed trading.

In accordance with Standing Instructions the case is submitted to the Committee in order that the standing record may be altered to "Sunk 12,38 - Refloated and now trading".
