Dear Sirs,

Reverting to your telegram of the 11th instant, regarding the freeboard of your S.S. No. 413, I have to confirm the telegram which has been despatched to you to-day with reference to this case as follows, namely,

"Your number 413 provisional summer freeboard eight feet three and half inches from statutory line one and three quarter inches above steel shelter deck side subject no tonnage opening and deck erections sixty-one feet length over engine and boiler space being closed at ends as required for full allowance",

and enclose herewith a memorandum giving particulars of the provisional freeboard assignment, subject to the particulars and dimensions being verified on completion, there being no tonnage opening, and no scuppers or other openings through the sides to affect the position of the loadline disc, and the deck erections 61 feet in length over the engine and boiler space being closed at the ends as required for full allowance, and the vessel being built in accordance with the approved plans.
