Particulars of Casualty

This vessel is reported to have run aground on dangerous sands in the River Hoochly on the 12th November, 1939.

The tide swung the steamer across the river and owing to the ebbing tide, tugs failed to refloat.

The following day she began to break up in several places and slowly settled in the sands with only part of the superstructure, funnel and masts showing above water.

No reply has been received to the casualty notice addressed to the Owners on the 30th ultimo.
