With reference to the Secretary's letter of the 25th instant "S" regarding Liverpool first entry report No.96691 on the steamer "SULTAN STAR", I beg to state that all the watertight bulkheads extend to the upper deck, and the riveting of the butts of the bridge and forecastle side plating is as required by the Rules.

The total length of the double bottom tanks is 433'0" and the capacity 1373 tons water ballast and 304 tons fresh water.
