Now Done: Examined H.P. & I.P. primary pinions wheels of both engines, found them in the same condition as stated in Liverpool Report. Recommended same be renewed at first convenient opportunity.

It is submitted that the Owners proposal to run the machinery at reduced power in the meantime is in our opinion worthy of the consideration of the Committee, provided that the gears be opened up and examined at Buenos Aires & London pending replacement.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:—The Machinery of this vessel so far as seen, is in a safe working condition & eligible in our opinion to remain as cleared subject to the H.P. & I.P. primary pinions wheels of both gears being renewed at first convenient opportunity & the gear being examined at Buenos Aires & London until the above condition has been complied with.
