I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter
Reverting to your letter of the 12th instant
enclosing a copy of one from the representatives of the Owners
of your T.S.S. No. 995, and to the statement that "It is the

plating are to be such as will with 50% deck erections obtain
a Summer load draft of 30ft. " I think it well to call your
