I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th instant relative to the steamer "SINT ANNALAND", and in reply I have to say that this case has received consideration today and that the Committee will be agreeable to your proposal to carry out the 2nd Special Survey No.1 of this vessel sometime within the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules, i.e. by the end of July, 1934.

It is noted that the Boiler Survey of this vessel is to be held when the boilers are next examined by the Government Inspectors and that the Screwshaft Survey will be carried out when the steamer is next drydocked, probably during next month.
