Particulars of Casualty Set on fire by the crew at Bandar

Abbas, Iran, about the 29th August, 1941.

She was towed to Bombay where it was stated that the vessel required drydocking for about one year, and in view of the Italian-built engines, she was considered irreparable during the war.

It is now reported that she has been beached and is being stripped.
