Kampens Verksted, Oslo, examine during construction 2 whaleoil apparatus with oil extractors to the order of the steamer "KOSMOS".

The apparatus built by Kampens Verksted, the oil extractors by Erik Rind's Verksted, oslo.

The scantlings are in accordance with the approved plans for a working pressure of 4,5 Atm. for the apparatus and 80 lbs. per sq. inch for the oil extractors.

The apparatus and oil extractors were on completion tested by hydraulic pressure to 10 kg.pr.cm.² and 160 lbs. per sq. inch respectively and found tight and sound.
