The propeller, sea cocks & valves and fastenings of the sea connections examined.

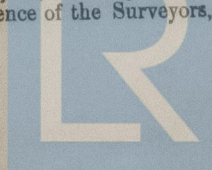
The after IP cylinder, cover, <sup>Cylinder</sup> piston and rod examined.
