

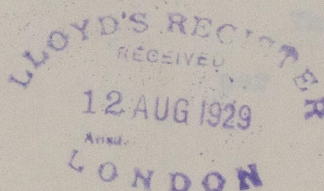

With reference to the First Entry Report on the steamer "KOSMOS" - Messrs. Workman, Clark's No.505 forwarded you yesterday, we beg to inform you that the Builders have been advised by wire to-day that the freeboards have been assigned by the Norwegian Authority as follows:-

Summer	18'.6 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
Winter	19'.2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
F.W.	17'.10 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
Tropics	17'.10 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
B O T Summer	18'.6 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

all measured from the top of Shelter deck plating.

We are also informed that the vessel is leaving Sandefjord to-morrow for Falmouth for dry docking, and as it is not clear whether the two outstanding items to complete the Survey have received the attention of the Oslo Surveyors we have to-day forwarded the necessary information to the Falmouth Surveyors for their action, if necessary.
