The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The Helsingfors Surveyors report this vessel examined afloat and a considerable part of the 3rd S.S.No.1, due 5,39 held, renewals or repairs effected to decks, ceiling, windlass, framing, tunnel, steering arrangements etc. and minor repairs carried out.

The Owners propose to complete the Survey at the end of this year and in the Surveyors' opinion this merits approval.

The Surveyors were not authorised to carry out the Survey but it is submitted the same might be accepted.

It is further submitted the recommendation be agreed to and that the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey.

Certificate of Classification to be endorsed "Cargo battens not" and the same notation to be in the Register Book.
