I duly received your letter of the 9th instant enclosing one from the City Line regarding the casualty record proposed for their steamer "CITY OF MANDALAY".

Following the Owners' remarks further representations were made to Government Authorities as a result of which permission has now been granted for the Society to revert to their original practice of making a notation of "Sunk - War Loss" against names of vessels lost by enemy action during the war. Permission has also been given for the month of casualty to be inserted, so that in the case under review a notation of "Sunk - War Loss 10,39" is now being posted in the Register Book.
